### YOUR JOB

- You will conduct world-leading research at post-doctoral level.
- You will also **assist one or two PhD students** in their research, as their daily supervisor, who will be working on topics directly related to your research.
- The topic of your research will be defined within the scope of the European Research
  Council (ERC) Advanced Grant VIGILIA (VIrtual Guardian angeLs for the post-truth
  Information Age), with Prof. Tijl De Bie as Principal Investigator.
- Your research will advance the state-of-the-art in Artificial Intelligence, and specifically
  in the intersection of Large Language Models, Knowledge Graphs, and user
  modelling. In the spirit of the VIGILIA project, you will develop novel methodologies with
  the aim of creating radically innovative approaches to mitigate the challenges of so-called
  mis-, dis-, and malinformation, while fully safeguarding the fundamental freedom of
  expression and of information.
- A limited portion of your time will be spent helping with the scientific project management of the VIGILIA project (following up the workplan, scientific reporting), with research data management, with organizational duties such as organizing scientific events (seminars, tutorials and summer schools, workshops,...) and public outreach activities, and with writing grant applications related to your research.
- You will be part of the <u>AIDA research group</u>, which is home to 12-15 researchers
  performing world-leading research on topics including the foundations of AI, data science,
  and machine learning, AI trustworthiness, visual analytics, and applications in areas such
  as the labor market, biology, and (social) media analysis. The AIDA research group is part

of the larger <u>IDLab</u> group, with research activities ranging from data science and AI to internet technologies and networking.

#### YOUR PROFILE

- You hold a doctoral degree or a diploma or certificate recognized as equivalent by law
  or in application of the guidelines of the European Union or a bilateral agreement, on the
  topic of Artificial Intelligence, computer science, cognitive science, behavioral economics,
  or a related field.
- In exceptional circumstances and based on detailed scientific justification, researchers
  who do not hold such a degree may also be considered, provided they have demonstrated
  exceptional scientific merit. Exceptional scientific merit is defined as having excelled in
  scientific research and publications at a level at least equivalent to a doctoral degree.
- You have an outstanding research track record for your career stage in several of the
  following, and have an interest in learning about the others: Al (specifically machine
  learning), Large Language Models, knowledge graphs, probabilistic modelling,
  cognitive science, behavioral economics. You have published influential scientific
  papers in leading conferences and/or journals in your research area.
- You have demonstrable experience with contemporary (AI) software paradigms.
- A keen interest in the **functioning of traditional and social media**, and its influence on the public debate and on democratic processes, is considered a plus.
- You are **fluent in English** and an **excellent communicator**, both orally and in written form
- The grant can only be awarded within the framework of international scientific mobility. This is the case if:
  - o the researcher has resided abroad (outside of Belgium) for at least 24 months out of the 3 years prior to the start date of the postdoctoral fellowship and has not worked or studied in Belgium during that period. However, short-term stays in Belgium are allowed during 24 months, such as holidays, participation in conferences or a short stay to prepare for the period as a postdoctoral researcher
  - the researcher is funded by the Marie-Sklodovska-Curie Action (MSCA) and thus meets the associated mobility conditions.
  - o only for postdoctoral researchers in international mobility.

## WHAT WE CAN OFFER YOU

- We offer a full-time position as a postdoctoral fellow, with a minimum period of 12 months (to be negotiated) which can be extended twice, considering the maximum period of 36 months.
- In deviation from the above, an EEA national, who has previously received a postdoctoral grant in the 12 months prior to an MSCA grant, can exceed the maximum term of 36 months under this MSCA grant provided that the entire term does not exceed 48 months.
- Your contract will start on 1 October 2024 at the earliest.
- The grant amount is equal to the net salary of a Doctor Assistant (AAP 5) with the same level of education and seniority and based on the same family situation as the Doctor

Assistant. The supervisor may deviate from this and assign a higher level based on acquired experience, professional career and demonstrated competences. The grant amount will not be revised in the current year except in case of indexation. Click here for more information about our salary scales
